- Write setting and character descriptions

### Maths

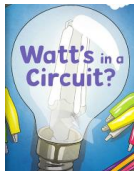
We use White Rose for the teaching of Maths:  
**Fractions A**

- Understand the denominators and numerator of fractions
- Compare and order unit fractions
- Understand the whole Compare and order non-unit fractions
- Fractions and scales Fractions on a number line
- Count in fractions on a number line
- Equivalent fractions
- Add fractions
- Subtract fractions
- Partition the whole
- Unit fractions of a set of objects
- Reasoning with fractions of an amount



### Science

This term we will be covering the topic 'Electricity', Children will learn:  
\* To classify and present data, identifying common appliances that run on electricity.  
\* To identify circuit components, build working circuits and investigate whether circuits are complete or incomplete.  
\* To investigate which materials are electrical conductors or insulators.  
\* To explain how a switch works in a circuit, build switches and report findings.
