Welcome Back!

Have a look at what we have planned for the start of our Summer term.

English

We use Literacy Shed to stimulate writing ideas and develop the construction of sentences. This term we are looking at non-fiction writing and we are focusing on a book called 'The Barnabus Project'. Within this, we will be focusing on adventure writing.



Alongside our standard English lessons, we will be focusing on our Set 1, 2 & 3 sounds. Using the Read, Write, Inc. Programme to support with this. There will be plenty of hands on, practical activities to support your child with their learning.

Maths

We use White Rose for the teaching of Maths:

Measure

- Measure in centimetres (cm), Measure in metres (m), Compare lengths and heights
- Compare mass, Measure in grams, Measure in kilograms, Four operations with mass
- Temperature, Compare volume & capacity, Measure in millilitres
- Measure in litres, Four operations with volume & capacity, temperature.

Statistics

Making tally charts, tables, block diagrams, Draw pictograms, interpret pictograms, draw pictograms.

Fractions

Introduction to parts and wholes, equal and unequal parts, Recognise a half, find a half, recognise a quarter, find a quarter, recognise a third, find a third, find the whole, unit fractions, non-unit fractions, recognise the equivalent of $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{2}{4}$, recognise three quarters and count in fractions up to a whole.

Science

This term we will be covering the topic of 'Plants'. We will look at parts of a plant, the plant lifecycle and what is needed to keep a plant healthy.

Physical Education

CM Coaching will lead both PE Lessons:
Lesson 1 will be learning the basics cricket and rounders..
Lesson 2 will be focussing on golf.
We will also continue with our weekly swimming lesson
