Have a look at what we have planned for the Autumn Term

### English

This term we are looking at, three stories, 'Daisy's dragons', 'A perfect fit' and 'Elmer', to stimulate writing ideas and develop the construction of sentences.



We will focus on lists, story maps and labels.

We will also have daily phonics sessions and 'Get writing sessions' for those who are able to access this.

### Maths

We use White Rose for the teaching of Maths:

#### Place Value

Sorting objects, counting objects, representing objects, recognising numbers as words, count on from any number, count one more, counting backwards, counting one less, comparing groups, fewer, more, the same, less than, greater than and equal to, comparing numbers, ordering objects and numbers, looking at number lines.

#### Adding and Subtracting:

Introducing part and whole, part-whole model, writing number sentences, fact families, number bonds within 10, addition, finding a part, subtraction, subtraction on a number line.

### Science

This term we will be covering the topic of 'Animals including humans'. We will be identifying some common animals, describing the structure of a variety of common animals, naming and sorting animals into herbivore, carnivore and omnivore.

We will name and label parts of the human body, moving onto identifying our five senses and performing simple tests to find out more about them.

We will finish our half term with some Awe and Wonder activities linked to science.

### Physical Education

CM Coaching or I will lead PE Lessons:

Lesson 1 will be learning the basics of the invasion game - Football.

Lesson 2 will be focussing on fitness levels through circuit training.

We will also have weekly swimming lessons on Mondays.

We will look at 'I am being more active' through our PACs Award.



### PACS

#### Park Alternative Curriculum Scheme

Park Alternative Curriculum Scheme is a progressive learning programme, designed around and for the children at Park Aspire AP Academy. It is a way of learning which enables children to progressively build upon the skills they may already have or develop new skills which will help them now and in later life.

The areas of PACs:

I am practising my cooking skills, I am investigating nature, I am working on my resilience, I am exploring my community, I am developing my social skills, I am building my communication skills through Lego Therapy, I am being more active and I am focussing on my feelings.

### Personal Development/POL-ED

The PSHE unit, 'Aiming High', looks at our own star qualities and which qualities people may need for different types of jobs. We will also consider how a positive learning attitude can help us. With all of this mind, we will consider the job we may want when to do when we are older and other achievements we have for our future.

In our POL-ED lessons we will be learning how to keep ourselves safe. Children will learn what is meant by the word trust and risk. We will learn how to keep safe online as well as during events such as Halloween and Bonfire night.
