English

This term, we'll dive into 'Supertato' exploring its characters and themes. Students will read the story, then use their creativity to design their own unique characters. We'll focus on character traits, illustrations, and storytelling, encouraging imagination and narrative skills through fun, engaging activities and class discussions.

They will continue to work through the Get Writing booklets provided alongside the Read, Write, Inc phonics scheme.



Maths

We use White Rose for the teaching of Maths:

Place Value

This term, we'll explore place value by focusing on numbers up to 20. Students will learn to identify the tens and ones in each number, using visual aids and hands-on activities. We'll practice grouping objects into tens and ones to solidify their understanding of the place value system.

Physical Education

CM Coaching will lead one PE lesson.
Lesson 1 will be practising football.
Lesson 2 will be focusing on games and team building.



Science

We'll explore animals, including humans, by examining their habitats, diets, and life cycles. Students will compare animal groups, study human body parts and functions, and engage in interactive activities. We'll use stories, videos, and hands-on experiments to enhance understanding of biology and animal diversity.

PACS Park Alternative Curriculum Scheme

Park Alternative Curriculum Scheme is a progressive learning programme, designed around and for the children at Park Aspire AP Academy. It is a way of learning which enables children to progressively build upon the skills they may already have or develop new skills which will help them now and in later life.
