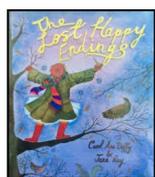

Science

This term we will be covering the topic of ' **Light**'

Children will learn:

How to distinguish between light and dark and classify different light sources. They will explore how light reflects off various surfaces and materials, and understand how the Sun can both help and harm us, along with ways to stay safe in its rays. They will also discover how shadows form and notice patterns in how their size changes.
