## THE FACTS

**1 IN 5** 11–17 year olds in the UK have tried vaping. (ASH, 2024)

**50%** rise in children vaping regularly since 2021. (NHS Digital, 2024)

**88%** of teachers are concerned about youth vaping. (ASCL, 2023)

## WHAT WE FOUND

Student research identified multiple vape-associated retailers within 1km of schools across Bradford, including:

- ✓ Dedicated vape shops
- ✓ Convenience stores
- ✓ Off licences
- ✓ Newsagents
- ✓ Petrol stations



Some schools had between **8 and 12** vape-associated retailers within a **1km radius**.

## OUR ASK

We are calling on the Government to:

- 1** Ban the sale of vapes within a 1km radius of schools and colleges.
- 2** Prevent new vape retailers from opening within 1km of schools.
- 3** Reduce the visibility of vape advertising around schools.
- 4** Better protect children and young people from nicotine addiction.
